In this process, the Financial Aid Office will compare information from your FAFSA with the financial documents you provide and make any necessary corrections. Corrections may affect your eligibility for aid. For students who are selected for verification, *files may take a number of weeks to be reviewed after all documents are submitted*. Additionally, the Financial Aid Office may request further information to complete the review process and financial aid may be held until all requested documentation is submitted and verification is complete.

How to order your IRS documents

Make sure to request the "IRS Tax Return Transcript and NOT the "IRS Tax Account Transcript."

- Transcript ONLINE – Go to www.irs.gov, under the Tools heading, click "Get Your Tax Record." Click "Get Transcript ONLINE."
- Transcript by MAIL – Go to www.irs.gov, under the Tools heading, click "Get Your Tax Record." Click "Get Transcript by MAIL." You will NOT be able to request your Verification of Non-filing or Wage and Income Transcript with the mail option.
- Paper Request Form – IRS Form 4506-T.
- Automated Telephone Request – 1-800-908-9946.
